Presentations: Dow Chemical

Shawonda Brockington and Michell LaFond presented on Dow Chemical Risk Management Plan requirements and 2024 drill dates. Dow submitted the Risk Management Plan to EPA in December of 2023. Dow's toxic chemical inventory consists of methyltrichlorosilane, dimethyldichlorosilane and trimethylchlorosilane. Worst case release scenarios were presented in regards to quantity of product and potential distance of impact.

1. Current Plans updating
 - AT&T Salzburg- Tier II report filed under Midland County, confirmed with City of Midland Fire Chief that they are physically located in Bay County. No further action needed.
 - Dow Silicones-working on summarizing the plan to minimize it from 200 pages
 - Quala-was missed in the last round, will be working on updating plan
2. Hazard Materials Release Education Video-Midland County Emergency Management and Emergency Public Health working with MCTV to create video around hazardous release and severe weather. Looking to have complete by September for National Preparedness month.

Record retention schedule-Jenifier working on this in the summer and will present at the Emergency Management Conference in October.

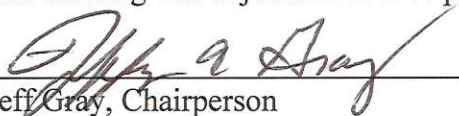
Round Table/Announcements
